

## DIRECTIONS TO THE FIRESIDE ROOM, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor

St. Paul's Episcopal Cathedral  
2728 Sixth Ave, San Diego, CA 92103

St. Paul's is located in the Banker's Hill area, on the West side of Balboa Park, between Fifth Ave and Sixth Ave and between Olive and Nutmeg Streets. (Nutmeg Street is just two blocks North of Laurel Street, the main entrance into Balboa Park from the West side.) Allow plenty of time to park and find the meeting room, since traffic and parking in this area can be intense on a Saturday.

**FIRESIDE ROOM:** To get to the Fireside Room where SDCRS is meeting, walk to the Fifth Ave main entrance to St. Paul's campus, in the middle of the block between Olive and Nutmeg Streets. Walk directly through the five Gothic arches into the courtyard. Cross the courtyard, going straight through to the office structure, immediately turn left to find the elevator, and go to third floor. Turn right (South) when you get off the elevator and walk the corridor above the courtyard to reach the Fireside Room, in the South corner of the office annex.

**PARKING:** On the Olive Street side of the St Paul's campus block is a new dark glass high-rise apartment building. On the map below from St Paul's website, this is labeled Construction Zone. St Paul's has some parking spaces designated in the new underground parking ramp (entrance at 525 Olive Street, between Fifth Ave and Sixth Ave) and is in the process of deciding what parking charges will be. Best information available right now is that parking for 3+ hours could cost \$9.

**STREET PARKING SUGGESTIONS:** Street parking in the area is available, including on Sixth Ave and also on Balboa Drive, which is parallel to Sixth Ave and a short distance East of Sixth Ave. **THE ONLY WAY TO ENTER** Balboa Drive (one way street headed South) is from Sixth Ave at Upas Street, where there is a stop light. Proceed on @ ½ mile on Balboa Drive (several more blocks after crossing Quince St) and park either in the nose-in slots to the right, near tall pine trees, or in parallel parking spots on both sides of Balboa Drive. After parking, walk WEST toward Sixth Ave across the small strip of park grass, and cross Sixth Ave at the marked crosswalk at Nutmeg Street. Walk around the short block to Fifth Ave, walk into the St. Paul's courtyard through the five Gothic arches, and proceed to the **FIRESIDE ROOM** as described above.
